

# Final instruction for EM/NM/DM Ring Djursland 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> May 2022

## **Track address:**

Ring Djursland  
AMU Centervej 2  
8500 Kolind  
Denmark

## **Paddock / setup:**

The paddock will be open from Thursday the 12<sup>th</sup> of may at 10.00  
the paddock area is inside the fence on tarmac  
there will be limited access to electricity in the paddock

Camp area must be appointed by one of the paddock bosses, Svend Erik/Bent Rasmussen/

## **Entry to the track.**

All riders must register at the Entry office, as a rider you will receive 3 weekend tickets, additional tickets are available to purchase at the entry office

## **AMK Race Office and registration for the Race**

The Race Officer will open Thursday afternoon at 14.00, in the yellow building in the middle of the paddock, bring you race license, transponder, receipt and other relevant materials that refer to your admission to the race.

Additional classes can only be entered/paid for at the race office

## **Payment: Only Credit Cards, Danish Kroner (DKK) or EURO (EUR)**

*Opening hours for the remaining weekend will be on the bulletin board located at the race office*

## **Transponder:**

If you don't have your own transponder, you can rent one at the AMK Race Office (subject to availability)  
Price – 300,- DKK. + valid ID as a deposit (driver's license/race license etc.)

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\* remember to return rented transponders as soon as the event is over and retrieve your ID**

## **Scrutineering**

The scrutineering tent is located next to the race office.

Opening hours will be available on the bulletin board at next to the race office and at the scrutineering tent  
Bottom fairing must be removed on race bikes (if you remove it at your camp, bring it with you to the scrutineering tent)

All personal protective equipment that you intend to use on track **MUST** be inspected at the scrutineering tent

**Rider's briefing:**

Rider's briefing will be held each morning by the Race Office

**Friday:** 8.00

**Saturday:** 7.00

**Sunday:** 8.00

The Riders briefing is obligatory for all riders, it is NOT sufficient to send a mechanic or other representative,

There will be random name calls, riders not present will not be permitted to ride

**Noise measurement:**

There may be noise checks of the bikes

**"Noise Hours"**

Starting and/or riding race bikes outside of the allotted "noise hours" stated in the environmental permit is strictly prohibited

Friday: 9.00 to 17.00

Saturday: 8.00 to 17.00

Sunday: 9.00 to 17.00

If the above is not respected, it **can** result in expulsion from the event

**Fire safety:**

All fire extinguishers **must** be placed so they are visible

**Environmental:**

All motorcycles **must be parked on an environmental mat/tray** when stationary in the paddock

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**“Vintage Administration Fees 2022**

*Like last years, riders wishing to participate to the FIM Europe Vintage Championships/ Cups must be holders only of their **National licence and starting permission**, without buying a FIM Europe Continental licence, but paying to the Organisers a **Vintage Administration Fee** that, for 2022, is fixed at **€.20,00 per event**.*

*Therefore, FIM Europe will invoice, after the event, the relative Administration fees to the **Organising Federation (FMNR)**, which has the duty to collect them from the riders”.*
